Ask the child <br> to choose a number written and start counting forward/backward by 1's or 2's or 10's. <br> Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress): Flash 2-digit numeral cards for <br> students to read aloud. Say a 2-digit number and ask students to write it. |
