<b>Numeracy Target:</b> Identify numerals 0 to 100 <a href="#">Numeracy Targets Chart</a>	
<b>Fluency Benchmark:</b> KY.2.NBT.5 Fluently add and subtract within 100.	
<b>Kentucky Academic Standard(s):</b> <a href="#">KY.1.NBT.1</a>	
<b>Student-Friendly Learning Target:</b> I am learning to write and say 2 digit numbers.	
<b>Suggested Student Grouping(s):</b> individual / group / whole class	
<b>Materials:</b> Head Full of Numbers game or ten-sided numeral dice 0-9	
<b>Activity Description:</b> Place two dice in a cup. Shake and dump out. Write a two-digit number and say aloud. (For example if the dice are 3 and 5 you could make 35 or 53.)	
<b>Teacher Notes:</b> Adaptions you can make: 1. Ask the child to order the numbers. 2. Ask the child to choose a number written and start counting forward/backward by 1's or 2's or 10's.	
<b>Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress):</b> Flash 2-digit numeral cards for students to read aloud. Say a 2-digit number and ask students to write it.
