| Activity Description: Place three dice in a cup. Shake and dump out. Write a number and say it <br> aloud. (For example if the dice are 3, 5, and 6, you could make 356, 563, 635, etc.) |
| Teacher Notes: Adaptions: 1. Ask the child to order the numbers. 2. Ask the child to choose a <br> number written and start counting forward/backward by 1's or 2's or 10's. |
| Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress): Flash 3-digit numeral cards for <br> students to read aloud. Say a 3-digit number and ask students to write it. |
