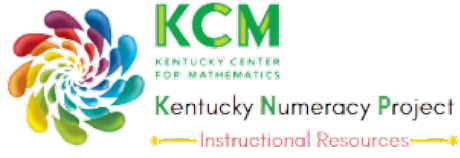


Lesson Plan for KNP Activity

Ni 1122.3: Comparing Numbers

Numeracy Target: Identify numerals 0 to 100 Numeracy Targets Chart

Kentucky Academic Standard(s): KY.1.NBT.1	
Student-Friendly Learning Target: I am learning to read and compare two-digit numbers.	
Suggested Student Grouping(s): partners	
Materials: two 0-5 number cubes, two 4-9 number cubes, writing space	
Activity Description: Working in pairs, students each toss a 0-5 cube and a 4-9 cube. Each student makes the greater two-digit number possible with his/her two cubes. Students compare numbers. The student with the greater number says the comparison statement ("75 is greater than 63") and writes the comparison on his/her recording sheet. The player who is first to record six comparisons is the winner.	
Teacher Notes:	
Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress): Show the child two numerals (such as 8 and 2) and ask her to make the largest 2-digit number possible using those digits. Repeat with another 2 digits (such as 3 and 5). Ask the child to again make the largest 2-digit number possible using those digits. Ask the child to compare the 2 numbers and write an inequality statement.	



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
