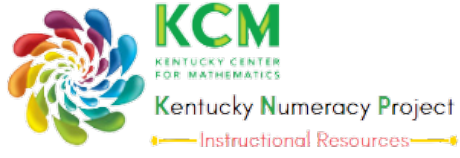


Lesson Plan for KNP Activity

S 2207.2: Race to Write (Ten Frames)

Numeracy Target: Intermediate structures to 10 Numeracy Targets Chart	
Fluency Benchmark: KY.1.OA.6 Fluently add and subtract within 10.	
Kentucky Academic Standard(s): KY.K.OA.4 , KY.1.OA.4 , KY.1.OA.6	
Student-Friendly Learning Target: I am learning to determine what goes with a number to make 10.	
Suggested Student Grouping(s): small group	
Materials: set of 10 frames 0 to 10, writing space	
Activity Description: Stack 10-frames face down on the table. Have students take turns turning over the top 10-frame. Others quickly write the number that goes with the quantity shown on the 10-frame to make 10. Ex.: if the student flips over a 4, remaining students race to write 6. The one who turned over the 10 frame (or teacher) is in charge of judging the winner of the round. Continue until someone wins 5 rounds. When all 10-frames have been used, reshuffle the frames and start again.	
Teacher Notes: Either pairwise or 5+ 10 frames may be used. For a simpler version, have students compete to write the amount shown on the 10 frame.	
Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress): Flash a 10 frame with 3 dots. Ask "How many dots? How many empties?" Do similarly for other frames.	



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
