Suggested Student Grouping(s): partner pair, small group
Materials: Bingo Boards filled with numerals 2-12, Bingo covers, two large dot dice (for example, 5" foam dice)

Activity Description: Bingo Addition: Each player should have a Bingo board (2-12) and covers. Players take turns finding the number that all players cover on their own board. On a player's turn, the player rolls the dice and finds the total. The first student to have a "Bingo" wins.

Teacher Notes: Students at this construct may need to touch the dots on both dice to determine the total.

Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress): Show student a 5 and a 4 on dot cubes and ask student "How many dots?". If desired, repeat with other amounts.
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
