## **Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress):**

Show the 10 card and ask student "How much is 10 plus 8?" Show student the 9 card and ask "How much is 9 + 8". Observe how student solves the task, looking for strategies that indicate the student is using the 10+ structure of the teens. For example, a student solving 9+8 may say "I know 10+8 is 18 so it's one less - 17".
