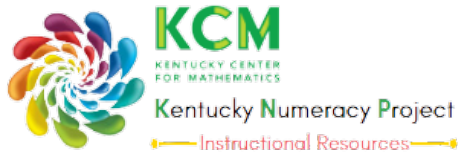
A 3321.5: Bingo Addition (13-20)

Numeracy Target: Add and subtract using a range of composite strategies Numeracy Targets Chart	
Fluency Benchmark: KY.2.OA.2 Fluently add and subtract within 20.	
Kentucky Academic Standard(s): KY.1.OA.6 , KY.2.OA.2	
Student-Friendly Learning Target: I am learning to use a known fact to mentally solve addition tasks.	
Suggested Student Grouping(s): partner pair, small group	
Materials: Bingo Boards filled with numerals 13 - 20, Bingo covers, double 10 frame cards 9 to 11 (several of each), numeral cube 4 to 9	
Activity Description: Bingo Addition: Each student will have a Bingo board (13 to 20) and covers. Players take turns finding the number that all players cover on their own board. The player should draw a card, roll the cube and find the total. The first student to have a "Bingo" wins.	
Teacher Notes: Teacher may choose to show the double 10 frame card for 2-3 seconds and then turn face down. Alternatively, teacher may replace the cards with a number cube labeled 10, 11, 12, 12, 13, 14.	

Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress):

Show the 10 card and ask student "How much is 10 plus 8?" Show student the 9 card and ask "How much is $9 + 8$ ". Observe how student solves the task, looking for strategies that indicate the student is using the 10+ structure of the teens. For example, a student solving $9+8$ may say "I know $10+8$ is 18 so it's one less - 17".
