| Materials: fingers |  |
| Activity Description: Finger patterns: Teacher will say "Show me 5 fingers." Repeat for other quantities 1 to 5 . Students may initially need to look at fingers or raise fingers sequentially. Teacher may ask students to make a fist between each pattern. Teacher may ask students to place their hands above their heads (to prevent students from counting their fingers). Teacher might encourage students to raise fingers simultaneously by saying things like "Quick as you can, show me...". Teacher may ask students to use their other hand. |  |
| Teacher Notes: This activity should be done over a period of weeks. Students may initially need to look at fingers or raise fingers sequentially. Activity should be repeated until students can quickly and simultaneously show quantities 1 through 5 on either hand. |  |
| Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress): Say to student "Put your hand on your head. Quickly, show me 3." Repeat for other quantities 1 to 5 . |  |

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
