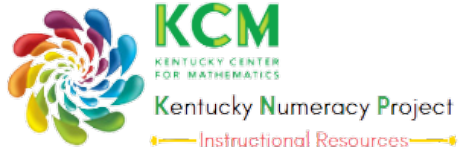

Numeracy Target: Count items arranged in equal groups with only group markers visible (items with groups are not visible) Numeracy Targets Chart	
Fluency Benchmark: KY.3.OA.7 Fluently multiply and divide within 100.	
Kentucky Academic Standard(s): KY.2.OA.3	
Student-Friendly Learning Target: I am learning to count by twos within 20 when I only see a marker (face) for each pair.	
Suggested Student Grouping(s): partners	
Materials: cowboy counters, card cover	
Activity Description: Ask your partner to put out any number of cowboy counters in a row and cover the feet with a card while you hide your eyes. Looking at the faces of the cowboy counters, find the number of cowboy boots they are wearing altogether. Repeat for different numbers of cowboys.	
Teacher Notes:	
Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress): Show 9 people with the heads visible and the feet covered. Ask, "How many feet do these people have?"
