<b>Suggested Student Grouping(s):</b> partners	
<b>Materials:</b> cowboy counters, card cover	
<b>Activity Description:</b> Ask your partner to put out a secret number of cowboy counters and cover them entirely while you hide your eyes. Ask your partner to give you a quick peek and then tell you how many cowboy counters are under the cover. Imagine the cowboys and tell how many boots they have altogether. Repeat for different numbers of cowboys.	
<b>Teacher Notes:</b>	
<b>Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress):</b> Show 6 people and cover them entirely. Say, "Here are six people. How many feet do they have?"
