Student-Friendly Learning Target: I am learning to tell the total of two collections within 20.

Suggested Student Grouping(s): individual or small group

Materials:

1 set of red and 1 set of blue counters.

Activity Description:

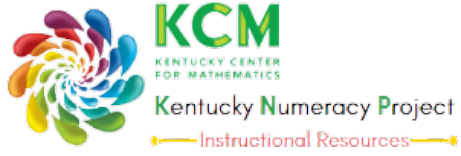
Given a collection of 2-20 counters, some red and some blue. Have the student tell how many altogether. Note the first addend should be greater than the second addend.

Teacher Notes:

Watch how students find the total number of counters. At this level student often will touch counters, count tiles on the floor, or numbers on a number line to keep track. They have to have something they touch, see or feel to determine total.

Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress):

Show the student counters to display one of the following: 7 red and 2 blue; 5 red and 4 blue; 9 red and 3 blue, etc. and ask her to tell how many in all.
