Lesson Plan for KNP Activity Nb 1102.5: Count Around (within 100)

Task Group Name: Count Around
Activity Level and Color: 5 Blue
and Student Instructions:
om any number within 100
and subtract within 100.
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Kentucky Academic Standard(s): <u>KY.K.CC.1</u>, <u>KY.K.CC.2</u>, <u>KY.1.NBT.1</u>

Student-Friendly Learning Target: I am learning to say number words backward from 100-1 and name the number word before a given number in the range of 100-1 without dropping back to do so.

Suggested Student Grouping(s): small group / whole class

Materials:

verbal

Activity Description:

Count Around Activity: Students stand in a circle. The first student starts the count at a number in the range of 20 to 100, as selected by the teacher, and the students count around the circle with each student saying the next number in the backward sequence down to the "stop" number, also selected by the teacher. The student who says the "stop" number sits down and the next child begins the count again starting at the same number as before. Repeat until only one child is left standing.

Teacher Notes:

To extend this activity to include skip counting, label individual index cards with the following: +1, -1, +10, and -10. As the students are counting around, the teacher will at various intervals hold up one of the cards. For example, he/she might show the +10 card which would require counting backward by 10's on or off the decade, depending on the previous number spoken. Other cards, such as +5 and -5, may be used similarly.

Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress):

Ask each student to name the number that comes right before various numbers in the range of 1-100.
