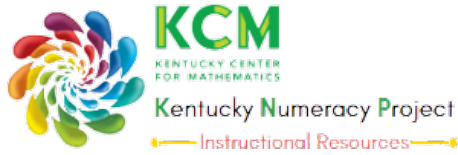
Nb 1104.5: Reading and Sequencing

Numeracy Target: Facile backward counting from any number within 100 Numeracy Targets Chart	
Fluency Benchmark: KY.2.NBT.5 Fluently add and subtract within 100.	
Kentucky Academic Standard(s): KY.K.CC.1	
Student-Friendly Learning Target: I am learning to read the number words backward in the range 100 to 1.	
Suggested Student Grouping(s): Partner	
Materials: numeral cards 1-100	
Activity Description: Sort cards into stacks of 10 (1 - 10 shuffled in one stack, 11-20 shuffled in another stack, 21-30 shuffled in another stack, etc. to 91-100 in the last stack). Place the stacks of cards face down on the table either in a row or a column. Turn over the top card on any two of the stacks and count backward from one number to the other.	
Teacher Notes: You can choose the range of numbers to target and only give students cards in that range building and extending the range as students gain fluency with the sequences. Note the student's abilities with problem areas, such as crossing the decade and repeated double digit numbers, such as 66.	

Evidence of Learning (Diagnostic Assessment of Progress):

Ask the student to start counting backward at 39 and ask her to stop when she reaches ten.
Repeat with other numbers and have students count backward from various starting numbers.
