- 5 "Make 5" Four in a Row Game Boards

[^0]Materials: 1 game board, approx 15 covers per player, a number or dot cube (0 to 5).

During a turn, the player rolls the cube and covers the number that goes with the number rolled to make 5. First player with 4 in a row wins.

[^0]:    Teacher Note: Initially, 5 frames may be used. If needed, the student could determine the number of dots needed to complete the frame by placing counters in the empty spaces. Alternatively, a tower of 5 snap cubes could be used. The player determines what would be left if 2 cubes are removed, then removes the 2 cubes as a check. Finger patterns or bead racks could be used as well. Ultimately the goal is for students to be able to determine the answer without support of materials and without counting.
