Sean checked out twelve library books. Three library books were on his shelf, five library books were on his table, and some library books were in his backpack. How many library books were in Sean's backpack?

Max has five red pencils, five blue pencils, and five yellow pencils. How many pencils does Max have in all?

Alice has some flowers on her desk. Six flowers are pink, three flowers are yellow, and two flowers are white. How many flowers does Alice have?

Linda has two notebooks in her desk, two notebooks in her locker, and five notebooks in her backpack. How many notebooks does Linda have?

Rhonda bought ten pieces of candy, four pieces of gum, and one cookie at the store. How many items did she buy?

Jeremy ate three pieces of fruit at breakfast, four pieces of fruit at lunch, and three pieces of fruit at supper. How many pieces of fruit did Jeremy eat?

Sarah had ten stickers. She gave two stickers to her sister, four stickers to her brother, and three stickers to her friend. How many stickers did Sarah have left?

There are thirteen pieces of fruit in a basket. Four are apples, six are pears, and the rest are bananas. How many bananas are in the basket?

<p>Patrick saved nine dollars last month, six dollars last week, and five dollars today. How much money has Patrick saved?</p>	<p>Matthew has ten stickers in his desk, three stickers in his backpack, and seven stickers at home. How many stickers does Matthew have?</p>
<p>Carlos has six trucks, seven cars, and three motorcycles in his Hot Wheels collection. How many Hot Wheels does Carlos have?</p>	<p>Layla planted five daisies, four tulips, and nine roses in her flower garden. How many flowers did Layla plant?</p>
<p>In Luke's refrigerator, there are six blue Gatorades, six orange Gatorades, and four red Gatorades. How many Gatorades are in Luke's refrigerator?</p>	<p>John had fourteen pieces of candy. He gave Erik three pieces, he gave Dana four pieces, and he gave Sean two pieces. How many pieces of candy did John have left?</p>
