<p>Erik has eight baseball cards and five football cards. How many cards does Erik have?</p> <p>3</p>	<p>Linda has seven red pencils, five blue pencils, and five yellow pencils. How many pencils does Linda have in all?</p> <p>4</p>
<p>Alice has some strips of paper on her desk. Seven strips are pink, three strips are purple, and six strips are black. How many strips of paper does Alice have?</p> <p>5</p>	<p>Sherry has nine pens in her desk, three pens in her locker, and five pens in her backpack. How many pens does Sherry have?</p> <p>6</p>
<p>Sean had twelve Xbox games and then he bought three more. How many games does Sean have now?</p> <p>7</p>	<p>Wesley ate five pieces of fruit at breakfast, five pieces of fruit at lunch, and three pieces of fruit at supper. How many pieces of fruit did Wesley eat?</p> <p>8</p>
<p>Ashton had twelve dollars. Her dad gave her three more dollars. How much does Ashton have now?</p> <p>9</p>	<p>Juan has six cousins, four sisters, and two brothers. How many are in Juan's family?</p> <p>10</p>

<p>LaTonya had some markers in her desk. Six were red, six were blue, and four were green. How many markers did LaTonya have in her desk?</p> <p>11</p>	<p>Latisha bought ten cupcakes, nine cookies, and one cake for her party. How many items did she buy?</p> <p>12</p>
<p>Jeremy has eight goldfish, two cats, and two dogs. How many pets does Jeremy have?</p> <p>13</p>	<p>Maria had fifteen stickers. Her friend gave her four more. How many stickers does Maria have now?</p> <p>14</p>
<p>Jeff saved ten dollars last month, five dollars last week, and five dollars today. How much money has Jeff saved?</p> <p>15</p>	<p>Matthew has ten stickers in his desk, three stickers in his backpack, and seven stickers at home. How many stickers does Matthew have?</p> <p>16</p>
<p>Jose had ten pieces of gum. His mom gave him four more pieces. How many pieces of gum does Jose have now?</p> <p>17</p>	<p>Antoine has nine chapter books, two non-fiction books, and three poetry books. How many books does Antoine have?</p> <p>18</p>
<p>In Luke's backpack, there are six blue crayons, six orange crayons, and four red crayons. How many crayons are in Luke's backpack?</p> <p>19</p>	<p>Carlos went to a party. At the party, there were eight grown-ups, five boys, and five girls. How many people were at the party?</p> <p>20</p>
