## Count Around (within 1000)

## I am learning to count within 1000. I can skip count backward by $5 \mathrm{~s}, 10 \mathrm{~s}$ and 100 s .

## Materials:

verbal

## Directions:

1. Have everyone in the group stand in a large circle.
2. Your teacher will call out a starting number between 100 and 1,000 and everyone in the circle will "count around," going backwards from that number.
3. During the count around, your teacher will hold up different cards that will ask you to add or subtract 1 or 10 to the last number you heard. For example, if your neighbor just said " 420 " and your teacher holds up the +10 card to you, you would mentally add 10 to 420 and say " 430 " and the count around would continue backwards from 430.
4. The count around will continue until your teacher says "stop."
