

## Count Around (within 1000)

I am learning to say the number words from 1-1000 and name the number word after a given number in the range of 100-1000.

### Materials:

verbal

### Directions:

1. Count Around activity.
2. Students stand in a circle. The first student draws a card, the *stop number* is then announced by the teacher. (If 267 is drawn as the start number the teacher may say, *We will count to 284.*)
3. The first student starts the count at the number on the card drawn and the students count around the circle with each student saying the next number in the sequence.
4. The student who says "*the stop number*" that was determined by the teacher sits down and the next child begins the count again at the same start number as before.
5. Repeat until only one child is left standing.
