Reading and Sequencing

I am learning to read the number words backward in the range 100 to 1.

Materials:

numeral cards 1-100

Directions:

- 1. Put the number cards into stacks of 10: Number cards 1-10 in one stack, number cards 11-20 in one stack, and number cards 21-30 in one stack, and so on until you have used all the cards to 91 100 in the last stack.
- 2. Make sure all stacks are turned over where you can't see the numbers.
- 3. Choose any **two** stacks to draw from and turn the top cards over so you can see them.
- 4. Begin counting **backwards** from the bigger number and stop when you get to the smaller number.
- 5. Keep doing this until all the cards are used.
