Task Group: Hidden Numbers

Kentucky Academic Standard(s): KY.K.CC.4

Numeracy Target: Facile backward counting from any number within 10

More or Less Game (1-10)

I am learning to tell the number word before in the range of 1 to 10.

Materials:

- More and Less Game mat
- numeral cards 4 cards each of numbers 1-10, for a total of 40 cards.

Directions:

- 1. Give each player 5 cards and put the rest of the cards in a stack, face down, beside the game board.
- 2. Take one card from the stack and put it in the middle of the game board. This is the starting card.
- 3. Look at your cards and try to find a number card that is one less than the starting card.
- 4. If you have a card that is one less than the starting card, you will lay it on top of the starting card when it's your turn. If you don't have a number card that is one less, you can pass until your next turn.
- 5. During each turn, be sure to tell the other players why you chose the card you played ("the starting card is 6, so I'm playing a 5 because 5 is one less than 6").
- 6. After each turn, draw a card from the stack.
- 7. Make sure each player gets a turn.
- 8. If no one has a card that is one less than the top card on the game board, draw a card from the stack to make a new starting card.
- 9. If a "1" ends up being the top card on the game board, draw another card from the stack and use it as the new starting card.
- 10. Keep playing until all the cards are gone from the stack.
