Task Group: Number After Race

Numeracy Target: Facile forward counting from any number within 30

Number After Race (10 to 30)

I am learning to say the number after any given number in the range 10 to 30.

Materials:

Number After Race (10 to 16) Game Board with cube labeled {10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15} OR Number After Race (15 to 30) Game Board with cube labeled {13, 19, 20, 21, 25, 29}, Game tokens

Directions:

- 1. All players begin with a token on the Start space.
- 2. All players roll the cube. The player who rolls the highest amount goes first.
- 3. Players take turns. On your turn
 - a. roll the number cube
 - b. determine the number after the number on the cube and move your token to the next space containing that number. For example, if you roll a 13, move your token to the next "17".
 - c. If the next space to contain the number after is the winner space, then move to that space.
- 4. First player to reach the "Winner" space wins the game.



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
