

Comparing Numbers

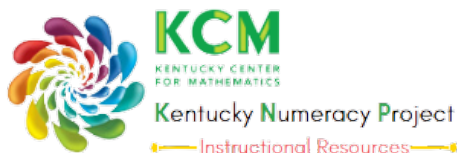
**I am learning to read and compare numerals
1-6.**

Materials:

two 6-dot dice or number cubes 1-6; writing space

Directions:

1. You and your partner each roll a die or number cube.
2. Compare the numbers rolled.
3. The student who rolled the greater number makes a comparison statement. (For example if the dice are 5 and 3 you could say, "5 is greater than 3")
4. The same student then writes the comparison statement.
5. The activity has finished when one student has written six comparisons.



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
