Comparing Numbers

I am learning to read and compare two-digit numbers.

Materials:

two 0-5 number cubes, two 4-9 number cubes, writing space

Directions:

- 1. You and your partner each roll one 0-5 number cube and one 4-9 cube.
- 2. Make the greater two-digit number possible with your two cubes. Then compare your number with your partner's number.
- 3. The student with the greater number makes a comparison statement. (For example "75 is greater than 63")
 - 4. The same student then writes the comparison statement.
 - 5. The player who is first to record six comparisons is the winner.



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
