## Comparing Numbers

## I am learning to read and compare two-digit numbers.

## Materials:

two 0-5 number cubes, two 4-9 number cubes, writing space

## Directions:

1. You and your partner each roll one 0-5 number cube and one 4-9 cube.
2. Make the greater two-digit number possible with your two cubes. Then compare your number with your partner's number.
3. The student with the greater number makes a comparison statement. (For example " 75 is greater than 63")
4. The same student then writes the comparison statement.
5. The player who is first to record six comparisons is the winner.
