

Fill the Pockets (sums to 10)

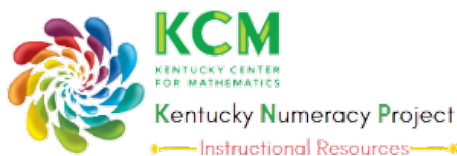
I am learning to combine quantities (addends up to 5) without counting.

Materials:

dot cards or 5 frame cards showing 1-5 dots - approximately 3 of each, game board, paper clips

Directions:

1. Shuffle cards.
2. On your turn, draw 2 cards and add the numbers on the cards together. Paperclip the cards together and place them in the pocket on the game board that equals the same total.
3. Students then take turns.
4. After finishing the game, each student predicts the pairs of numbers located in each pocket. After all the predictions have been made, students remove the cards from each pocket and compare the answers to their predictions.
