

Four in a Row (Make 5)

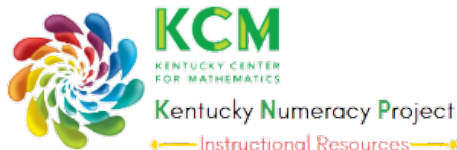
I am learning to tell the number needed to make 5.

Materials:

6X7 Four in a Row board with numbers 0-5, cube with numerals 0-5 or 5 frames 0 to 5, counters to use as game covers

Directions:

1. Get the Four in a Row board, cube (or 5 frames) and counters.
2. Players each select 1 color to use as a cover.
3. Player 1 rolls the cube and places a marker on a number that goes with the number rolled to make 5 (i.e. student rolls a 2, student then covers a 3).
4. Player 2 takes a turn.
5. Play continues until someone has 4 in a row.
