

Four in a Row (Make 10)

I am learning to tell the number needed to make 10.

Materials:

- 6X7 Four in a Row board with numbers 3-8,
- die with numerals 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 (or 10 frames with 2-7 dots)
- Counters to use as game covers

Directions:

1. Get the Four in a Row board, cube (or 10 frames) and counters.
2. Players each select 1 color to use as a cover.
3. Player 1 rolls the cube and places a marker on a number that goes with the number rolled to make 10 (i.e. student rolls a 4, student then covers a 6).
4. Player 2 takes a turn.
5. Play continues until someone has 4 in a row.
