Four in a Row (Totals to 20)

I am learning to fluently add two sets of dots or beads when each set is 10 or less.

Materials:

- 6X7 Four in a Row board with numbers 10-20
- 10 frames filled will 5 to 10 dots, at least 2 each
- counters to use as game covers

Directions:

- 1. Get the Four in a Row board, frames (or cubes) and counters.
- 2. Players each select 1 color to use as a cover.

3. Player 1 turns over 2 cards, looks at them briefly and turns them over. Player then covers a number that is the total. (Alternatively, player may roll 2 cubes and find sum.)

4. Player 2 takes a turn.

5. Play continues until someone has 4 in a row.
