

Make the Target (up to 10)

I am learning to tell the number needed to add to make the given total, 6 to 10.

Materials:

numeral cards, 2 each of 1 through 5 OR 2 each of five frames with 1 to 5 dots with numeral written on reverse side; cube with numerals 6, 7, 7, 8, 9, 10.

Directions:

1. Get cards and cube.
2. Place cards numeral side up on the table.
3. Player 1 rolls the cube to find the target number.
4. Player 1 chooses a card to be the first addend.
5. Player 2 chooses a card that will go with the first addend to make the target number. If using cards with five frames, turn over cards to verify total.
6. Players switch places and begin again.
7. Players continue to take turns.

One player directions:

Roll the cube. Find two cards that add to make the number rolled. Play again.
