

How Many?

I am learning to use counters to help me solve word problems with up to 3 numbers.

Materials:

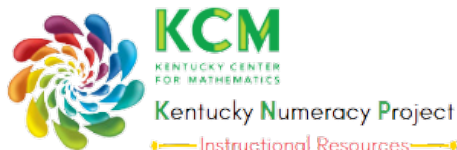
question cards, working mat, counters

Directions:

1. Get a working mat and all the cards from the folder.
2. Mix up the cards and put them face down in front of you.
3. Draw a card.
4. Use counters on your working mat to help you figure out the answer.
5. Share your answer with your partner or teacher.
6. Clear your board and repeat.

* To make this a partner game, give each student a working mat. Have them follow the above directions.

When each student totals his/her counters, the student with the most/least gets a point (K.CC.6). Play until one student has 5 points.
