When Bugs Attack

I am learning to count groups of hidden items using skip counting to find the product.

Materials:

- Bug Game Card: 120 cards total, 4 sheets: Fly Cards: 2 wings; Butterfly Cards: 4 wings; Spider Cards: 8 legs; Ladybug Cards: 6 legs; Ladybug Recording Sheet: one per person

Directions:

Set Up:

- 1. Each player gets a ladybug recording sheet.
- 2. Sort the bug game cards by bug types. Place those cards in four different stacks face up in the middle of the group.

Game Play - On your turn:

- 1. Select ten bug game cards from one of the four piles.
- 2. Record your bug type and value on to your recording sheet. (Hint: This value will be the number in each group.)
- 3. Say "Bug Attack!" and toss the bug cards up into the air.
- 4. Count the number of bug cards that are lying face down. (Hint: This will be the number of groups.)
- 5. Record your equation on to your recording sheet.
- 6. Using skip counting, find your total and record it on your recording sheet.
- 7. Play will continue until all players have played the activity with all four sets of bug game card.

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
