## **Cups O' Gold**

## I am learning to model a two-digit number using groups of ten.

## **Materials:**

arrow cards (ones and tens only), tub of yellow unit cubes ("gold pieces") or other small counters, 10 portion cups with lids for each student.

## **Directions:**

- 1. Get the tub of "gold pieces" and place where all players can reach.
- 2. One player will randomly draw a "ones" arrow and a "tens" arrow and put them on the table for all players to see.
- 3. Each player will use portion cups to make the amount shown. Exactly ten "gold pieces", no more and no less, go in a cup and less than ten pieces can be kept loose.
- 4. Compare answers and make sure everyone is correct.
- 5. Take turns drawing arrow cards and having each player make the number.



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
