## Materials:

Two sets Arrow cards for group- hundreds, tens and ones, Base ten blocks for group - 10 flats, 20 longs and 50 units, Recording Sheet, Building Space

## Directions:

Shuffle arrow cards and place them in stacks separated by place value

## Students will take turns:

- Draw one hundreds, one tens and one ones arrow card
- Place the cards together and write down first number
- Repeat for second number
- Write the total value
- Students will explain to classmate their thinking using words or base ten blocks
