

## Chunk It

I am learning to decompose a number into hundreds, tens and ones in two different ways and write the matching addition sentences.

### Materials:

Two sets Arrow cards for group- hundreds, tens and ones, Base ten blocks for group - 10 flats, 20 longs and 50 units, Recording Sheet, Building Space

### Directions:

**Shuffle arrow cards and place them in stacks separated by place value**

### Students will take turns:

- **Draw one hundreds, one tens and one ones arrow card**
- **Place the cards together and write down first number**
- **Repeat for second number**
- **Write the total value**
- **Students will explain to classmate their thinking using words or base ten blocks**
