## Directions:

Shuffle arrow cards and place them in stacks separated by place value
Students will take turns:

- Draw one thousands, one hundreds, one tens and one ones arrow card
- Place the cards together and write down your first number

Repeat for second number
Write your expression down
Explain to classmate your thinking using words or base ten blocks
