# First to 20


Game 24, Pg. 61 (Derived Fact Strategies - Addition and Subtraction)

**Game Goal:** Be the first player to have an exact score of 20.

Materials: one die, one recording sheet and dry-erase marker per player

# How to Play (2-4 players):

- Players take turns rolling the die and record their number on their recording table. 1.
- 2. On each turn, the player adds the number they rolled to their total from the last round and explains how they added.
- If a roll results in a sum greater than 20, the player must instead subtract the number rolled 3. and explain how they subtracted.
- 4. The game ends when one player has an exact score of 20. If no one has 20 when all recording sheets are filled, the player closest to 20 wins.



#### Game in Action:

### Variations:

- Start at 20 and countdown to 0. Subtract amount rolled each time unless the amount would be less than 0.
- Use a 10-sided die and let 0 be "wild".
- Play First to 30.
- Play First to 100 using one or two 10-sided dice. (Use a second recording sheet per player to allow additional turns.)
